Local firms partner with RAH competition finalists

Six South Australian architecture firms have been selected to work with the shortlisted finalists for the next stage of the RAH design competition.

The South Australian firms are Roarkus Moss, Mulloway Studio, Siteplan, Dash Architects, Phillips Pilkington Architects and Taylor Cullity Lethlean.

Deputy Premier John Rau said that the firms will bring important skills and local knowledge to the process.

“The competition rules require the shortlisted design teams to pair up with a local architecture firm to further develop their initial submissions.

“The local knowledge and context that these firms will bring to the process will be critical to developing the final submissions which are due to be released in mid-November.

“We have seen some interesting designs so far, now, using feedback from the public and interested parties, the designs will now be taken to the next level.”

The Australian Institute of Architects and the Australian Institute of Landscape Architects have endorsed the ‘local participation’ condition prior to Stage 1.

- Bonhag & De Rosa (Germany) with Taylor Cullity Lethlean

The final competition submissions are due on 14 November 2013, and a People’s Choice Award will launch on 22 November, providing an additional opportunity for the community to get involved and comment on the design possibilities.
